**“WIDDOW ORPHANS SCHEME 2020-21”**

**in the loving memory of our beloved father and founder-chairman of this institution Shri Jagdish Lal Bhatia, school management has launched third scheme namely “WIDDOW ORPHANS SCHEME 2020-21” in short “WOS 2020-21” today on 29/10/2019, the day when he left us five years ago, with effect from 01/04/2020 for the session 2020-21 and this scheme has been launched only on behalf of our school and the motive behind the scheme is to promote the education of those kids who have lost their mother or father or both. Our school has implemented this scheme with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 so it is clear that the guardians who have admitted their kids in the last sessions up to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019 will not be able to avail the benefits under this scheme namely “WOS 2020-21”. Parents should keep one point in their mind that this scheme is the self financed and self feeding scheme by the school management and it is not granted by any of the govt. agencies, therefore, school management has a right to withdraw the benefits availed by the parents if at any stage during the study it is found that parents have provided the wrong or false information in their affidavit submitted with the school so the**

parents are advised to give the true and correct information in their affidavit, If the parents want to avail the benefits under the “WOS 2020-21” they have to submit an affidavit mentioning that :-

- A. He/she is the guardian of the (name of the student) and ready to bear all the expenses levied by the school.
  - B. His / Her mother/ father has expired on (date)
  - C. He/she is the sole earning hand in the family.
  - D. His income from all the sources is less than rupees two lakh only (Rs.200000) per annum.
  - E. He is not having any four wheels pvt. /commercial vehicle.
  - F. If any of the points mentioned above is found wrong or any information given by the parent is found wrong then school has a right to withdraw all the benefits under the “WOS 2020-21”.
1. Guardians have to pay half charges of all of the fees accordingly for all the kids at the time of admission and half transport charges payable in twelve months. All the books and a set of uniform (summer & winter) will be provided at the discount of 50% to all the kids studying in our school under this scheme and an extra set of uniform can be purchased without any concession by the parents in order to send their kids in neat n clean uniform.
